Reading: Ezra 2:64-70

Outline:

- 1. Elite Leaders to Community (64-67)
- A redux is to bring something back./to revive something.
- Israel is in a covenant relationship with God. However they constantly rebel against God.
- There was a massive assembly of over 4,000 people to hear God's word.

Q: What does this tell us about the relationship between God and his people?

- 2. Narrow Holiness to Spreading Holiness (68)
- Without direction from Moses, without a priest or a prophet telling them, they know what to do.
- Holiness is spreading. The remnant recognize the sacredness of this place and this time and enter into it through ritual.
- As opposed to heading into the day thinking everything you have to face is on you, it reorients you to live from a place of being-at-home in God.

Q: What kind of rituals should we have?

- 3. Oral Authority to Written Authority (69-70)
- Post Exilic Period (Second Temple)
- Through God's word, we see him speak through the prophets.

• God's word binds his people together.

Q: How does God work through his people?
