Romans 1:18-25

1. What is implied by the word “suppress”?

Romans 1: 21-25

1. In verse 21, Paul writes: “For although they knew God....” How did they know Him? What did they know about Him?
2. What does it mean that “...God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts... “?
3. What are the “exchanges” that take place as a result of suppressing the truth? How are they related?

Reflection:

1. What are some ways, unbelievers and believers, suppress the truth?
2. Look back at v.17; why do you think Paul, starting with v.18, takes a “negative” turn?
3. In light of the Romans passage, discuss Jesus’s words in John 14:6: “...I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”
