Introduction:

Scripture:

Read Daniel: 2:1-19 and answer the following questions:

- 1. King Nebuchadnezzar has a disturbing dream, so he summons the wise men who have apparently helped him in the past: magicians, enchanters, sorcerers, and astrologers. This time, however, he demands that they not only interpret his dream but also tell him what he dreamed. **Why?**
- 2. The situation seems to be especially "high-stakes" for King Nebuchadnezzar. What tells you this? Why do you think it's so high-stakes?
- 3. Compare and Contrast the wise men's modus operandi (way of doing things) with Daniel's.
- 4. Compare and Contrast Nebuchadnezzar's response to the wise men and Daniel's.
- 5. What is God responsible for in this scenario?
