Drawing Near with Confidence

- Reflect on Hebrews 10:19-22 and discuss how the concept of drawing near to God with confidence impacts our ability to hold onto something unchanging in the midst of life's changes.
- How does the assurance of entering God's rest relate to the idea of holding onto Jesus as our unchanging anchor?
- Share personal experiences or stories where trusting in God's work rather than relying solely on human effort led to experiencing His rest and peace.

Holding Fast to His Promises

- Explore Hebrews 10:23 and discuss the importance of holding fast to our confession of faith in light of the warning not to fall into disobedience.
- How can trusting in God's promises, as demonstrated by the Israelites' failure, be seen as an act of holding fast to His work in our lives?
- Reflect on situations where trusting in God's promises helped you remain faithful despite challenges and uncertainties.

Trusting in the Intercession of Christ

- Delve into Hebrews 10:24-25 and examine the significance of Jesus as our great high priest in providing a foundation for holding fast in our faith.
- How does the understanding of Jesus' continuous intercession impact the way we approach God in times of need?
- Discuss Hebrews 10:26 and how approaching the throne of grace with confidence impacts our ability to hold fast to God amidst trials and temptations.

Reflection/Application Questions:

- Compare holding onto God amidst life's changes to other things we may cling to for security. How does our faithfulness to God's promises differ from relying on worldly assurances?

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Suggestion for Further Study:

- Psalm 119:105: Reflect on the significance of God's word as a lamp to our feet and a light to our path in providing guidance and assurance.

- Romans 8:31-39: Explore how God's unfailing love and promises provide security and confidence in the midst of trials and tribulations.
